Foster Contract THE Rabbit Resource

As a volunteer foster for THE Rabbit Resource, I understand:

- the foster rabbit is the property of THE Rabbit Resource and I will comply with any directives from TRR concerning the rabbit
- the commitment per rabbit may be up to a year
- the courtesy of a 3 month notice is requested when discontinuing foster duties
- I will need to maintain contact with TRR about the health of the foster rabbit
- I will be expected to provide a short bio and photos of the foster for advertising
- I will not sub foster
- I will not physically abuse him/her
- I will not allow any other person or animal to do so
- I will always supervise any children when they are playing with this rabbit
- I will house the rabbit in a safe and appropriate environment including bunny-proofing and monitoring the ambient temperature
- I will provide this rabbit with a balanced diet with daily fresh food, water and exercise
- I will notify THE Rabbit Resource of any changes to my address, employment status, or any event that will impact the rabbit (birth, new family member, new pet)
- I will not bond the foster (s) unless specific arrangements are made with a board member of TRR
- any veterinary services, including emergency and/or euthanasia, will be arranged by TRR, at the convenience of the foster
- TRR will place a rabbit with a foster that is within the scope of the foster's care ability. Help is always available
- TRR will make every effort to spay/neuter the rabbit in foster care in a timely manner, generally within 6 months of placement
- I am allowed to advertise my foster, but I must reference and direct all interest to TRR for any potential adoption
- all adoptions and paperwork will handled by a TRR board member
- I will notify TRR immediately if I notice any problem or appearance of illness in the rabbit
- I will not use any Lysol (or similar) cleaning product regardless if it is labeled 'pet safe', and will limit plug in and environmental sprays and candles as these harm rabbits

I have considered the potential for, and have ideas in case of:

- allergies in my home to the hay, bedding, or animal
- the need to move to different housing
- the continued financial obligation of a pet (food, medical) in the event of a division in the home or loss of partner or income
- any damage or injury caused by the rabbit is not the responsibility of TRR

I have read this agreement and will abide by its terms, valid until 12/31/26 or as determined by TRR and the foster.
